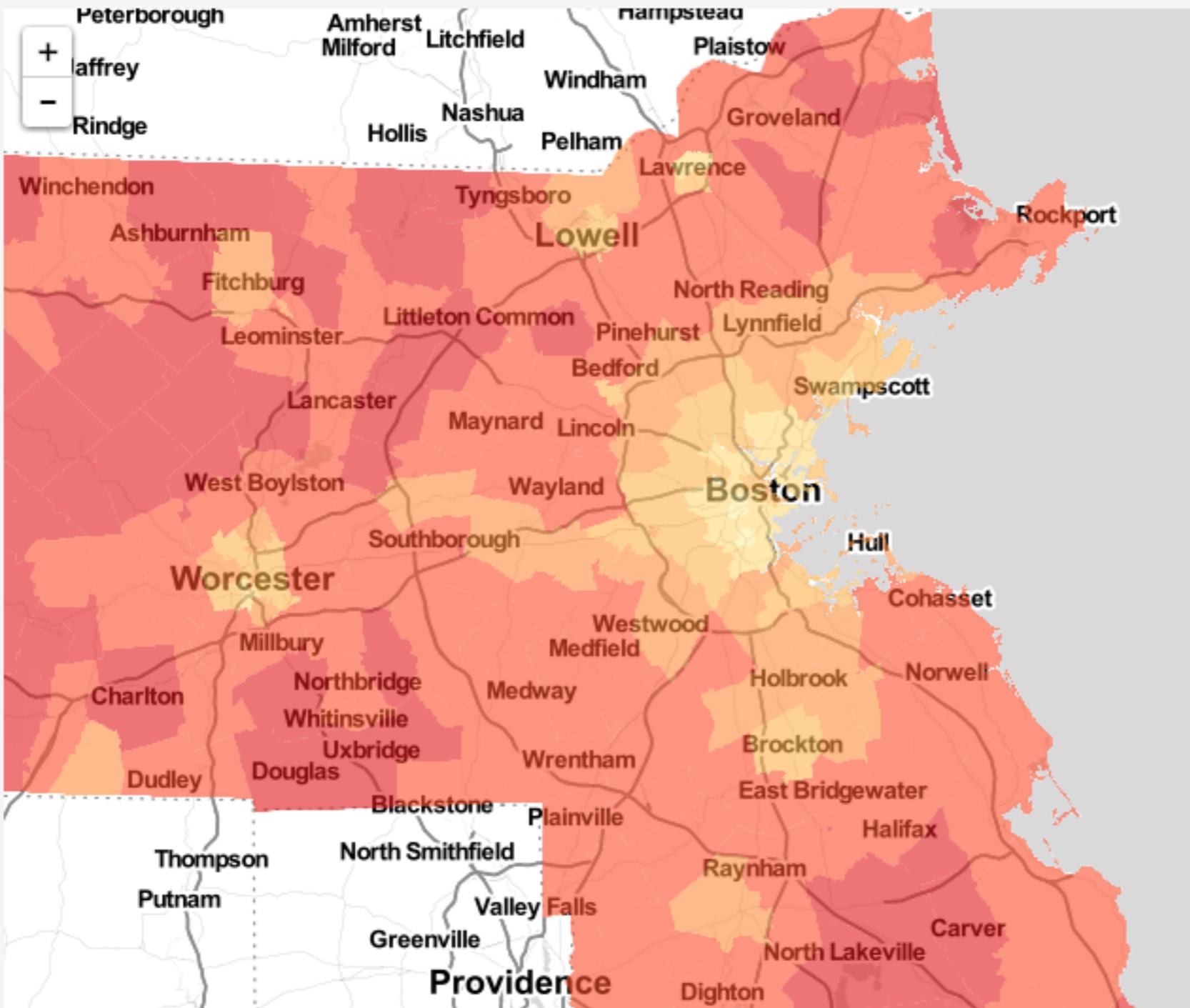
Driving and Land Use: An Explanatory Model

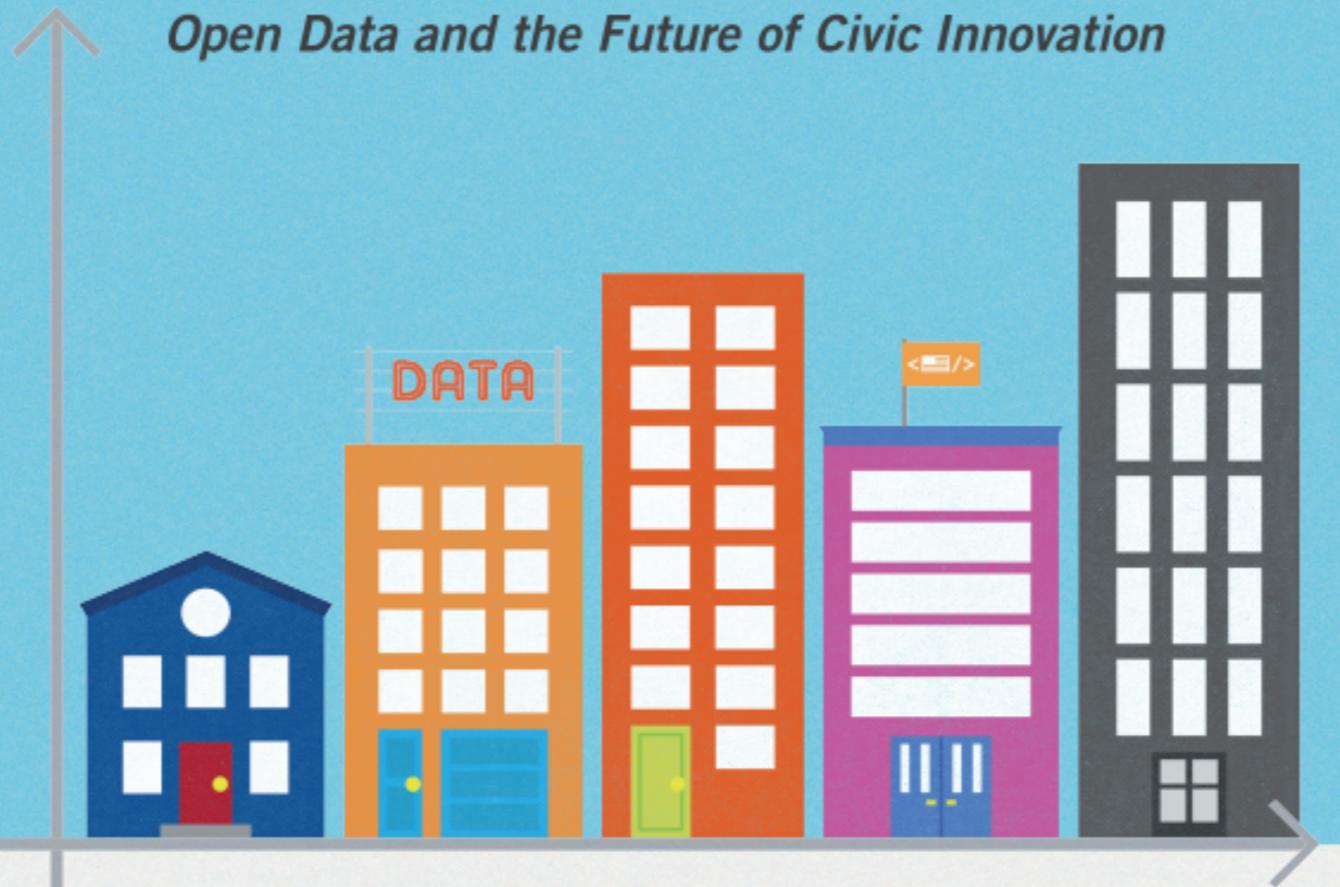

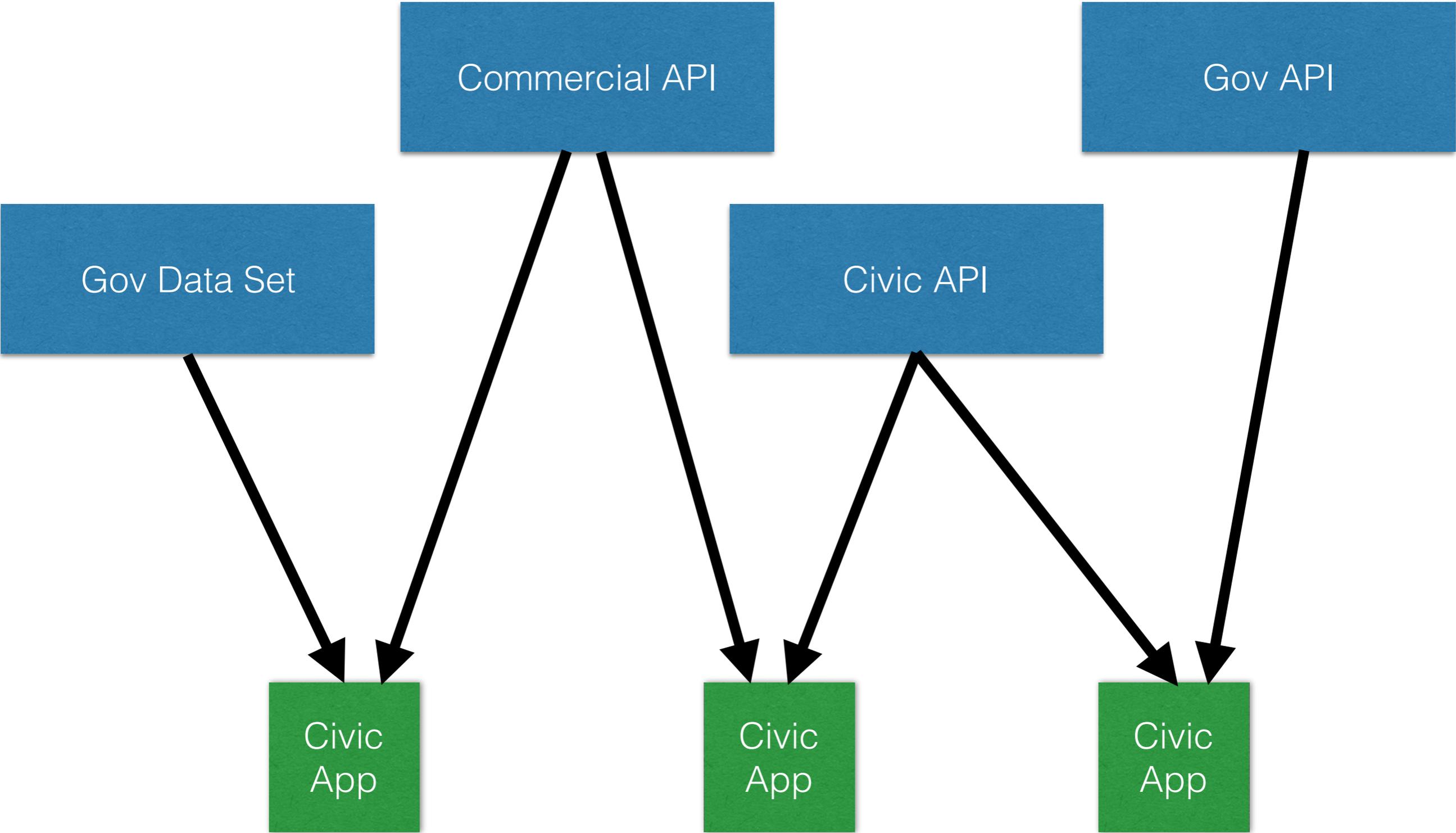

If you're a registered voter in Georgia, then **YES**, you can vote early. No reason is required to vote early.

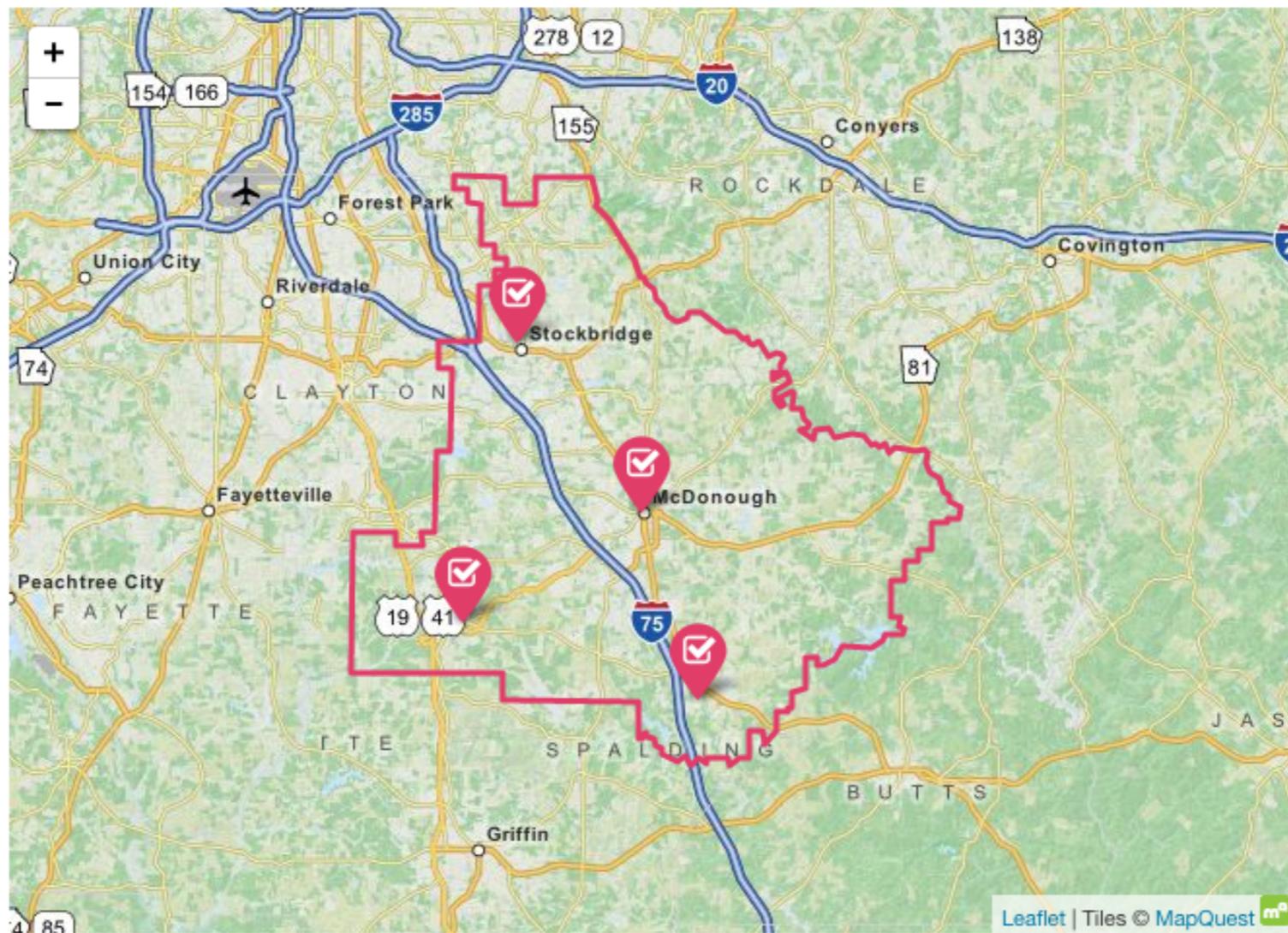

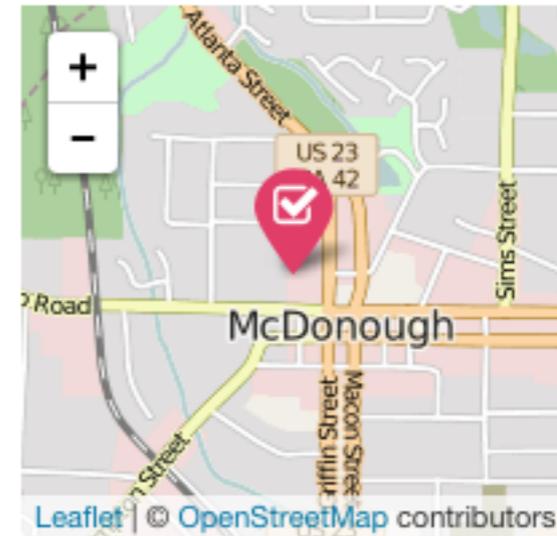
