

1994-1998: The Stone Age



In addition to the basic materials, a number of safety-related items were needed to conduct this experiment. First, a suitable location for the experiment was required, it being expected that the kitchen was not the appropriate place for blow-torching SPTs. The author's driveway was chosen as a suitable site. Second, an appropriate means for extinguishing the SPTs would be needed, a research assistant brought along some baking soda for the purpose.





Collecting or Paying Child Support

The Department of Human Services' Division of Child Support Services helps you collect or pay child support.

What You Should Know:

- Before opening a child support case, collect any relevant documents your children's birth certificates and Social Security cards, court custody orders, proof of income, and contact information for both parents.
- Private agencies may claim to help you collect child support, but many of these will charge you a fee. Be suspicious of them. The Division of Child Support Services offers assistance at little or no cost, and you'll receive 100% of child support payments owed to your family.

FAQs:

How do I file for child support?

- Apply online and pay the \$25 fee by credit card, money order or personal check. If you receive benefits from Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF) or Medicaid, you can apply for free.
- 2. Find the parent who doesn't have custody. Where does that parent live and work?
- If you're a mother, confirm that the father is legally recognized as a
 parent. If you aren't sure who your child's father is, Child Support Services
 will help you set up an appointment for genetic testing.
- 4. File a support order.




